The Curaçao Airport Partners N.V. (CAP) accepts its responsibility towards the environment and is committed to reducing and limiting the impact of our activities on the environment.

CAP values the health and wellbeing of its employees and all stakeholders that use and visit the airport and believe that everyone has a right to operate in a safe environment.

Therefore CAP will:

- Promote the Company's commitment to the environment, to our employees, tenants, customers and passengers.
- Develop and review measurable objectives and targets that promote the continuing improvement of our environment.
- Evaluate all its operational processes to minimize all wastes of energy and improve efficiency in energy use. It will also research and select sustainable sources of energy production.
- Create a training & awareness program to develop the idea of environmental responsibility in its entire staff.
- Comply with all relevant local environmental legislations, and international standards as established in its contractual obligations (World Bank Group General Environmental Guidelines) and other applicable internationally used standards for sustainability.
- Establish a vehicle emission control and switch to a more fuel efficient vehicles fleet and other sustainable transportation means where possible.
- Replace aged equipment and replace them with equipment that is energy efficient.
- Search for ways to reduce the production of waste due to its operations and the reuse of some waste material.
- Invest in an infrastructure that will make it possible to treat some of its waste water on site and other in the municipal recycling plants.
- Measure the greenhouse gas emissions of its activities and put in place a system to continue monitoring its emission to ensure a continuous and sustained reduction.
- Encourage airlines and clients to adopt similar principles by rewarding proven positive contributions to the environment while ensuring the ones violating environmental legislations are reprimanded
- Perform a financial analysis of the needed resources for carbon emission reduction developments. Then make the resources available, when they can be in a financially responsible way for the company.
- Look for alternative and more environmentally friendly ways for procuring energy
